Huron at Western awards up to ten International Presidential Scholarships worth \$100,000 over four years (\$25,000 per year) to entering international students who display outstanding academic achievement together with a strong record of extra-curricular activities. If you anticipate having a mid-year average of 90% or higher, we encourage you to apply for an International Presidential Scholarship. The application deadline is February 15th, 2020. Your application will be evaluated on a combination of the following three criteria:

- 1. Academic excellence with a mid-year average of 90% or higher;
- 2. Demonstrated passion for extra-curricular activities and leadership in your school and/or community; and
- 3. An evaluation of your two essay responses and your two reference letters.
